My focus is on local projects and progressing our commitments to you. Projects are underway and many have been completed.

We know many Goldfields families are under pressure, and that's why tackling cost of living is our number one priority.

Since coming to office we've:

- ✓ Introduced the WA Rent Relief Program, giving tenants at risk of eviction up to \$5,000 in direct rental support.
- ✓ Paid **\$1,400** in electricity credits to every household in WA.
- ✓ Kept water and power fees and charges increases to well below inflation.
- ✓ Reintroduced the Seniors Security Rebate.

- ✓ Increased the seniors cost of living rebate.
- ✓ Doubled the KidSport vouchers program, helping parents cover the cost of kids in sport.
- Continued to support the WA Seniors
   Discount Directory, helping our seniors
   with cost of living.
- ✓ Paid \$650 in small business electricity credits across WA.
- ✓ Introduced more than 130 Fee-Free TAFE courses across priority industries.
- ✓ Provided free Flu Shots to keep your family, your friends, and your community safe during the flu season.
- ✓ Provided a \$3,000 cost of living payment for all public sector workers, including nurses, police, and firefighters.
- ✓ Extended Water Corp's hardship support to an additional 5,000 customers.

### A 'Win' as Blood Donation Facility Returns

I've been leading the push for the return of a Blood Donation facility in the Goldfields for over 2 years. In June 2023, Nick Fardell and Doug Daws joined forces with me in this fight and collectively we created a community petition, which received an incredible 2045 signatures.

I am extremely grateful that following my strong advocacy with Lifeblood, they have finally agreed to reinstate the blood collection service in Kalgoorlie-Boulder as a pop-up facility before June 2024.

It has been 10 years since it was taken away and now it's coming back! This was a hard won battle, and I thank everyone who feels as passionate about returning the blood donation facility as I do.

### **Youth Mental** Health - zero2hero

In March 2023, a week of suicide prevention programs run by mental health charity zero2hero was carried out across football clubs in the Goldfields, continuing the charity's presence in Kalgoorlie-Boulder. The first safeTALK training session took place at



Kalgoorlie City Football Club, followed by sessions at Railways, Mines Rovers, and Kambalda football clubs.

This follows the 2,600 high schools and primary school Goldfields students, who in 2022, received skills to recognise mental skills symptoms — in themselves and their mates and learn how they can get help.

In 2024, zero2hero will be back again in our schools. plus running their Goldfields zero2hero Camp.





### Goldfields Women's Refuge Gets \$550,000

It was an honour to have the Minister for Community Services, Sabine Winton, in Kalgoorlie-Boulder to present the Goldfields Women's Refuge with a Lotterywest grant of \$450,000 in March—and then I presented another \$100,000 in November 2023.

The Lotterywest grants will support additional temporary accommodation, doubling the capacity of the refuge up to 72 beds.

Our region relies on the wonderful work of the Goldfields Women's Refuge, and I'm so proud to be part of a government that prioritises preventing family and domestic violence in our community and keeping families safe.



### **International Nurses Day**

### **Leonora Aged Accommodation**

In November, I joined the Minister for Regional Development and Seniors and Ageing, the Hon. Don Punch, and Parliamentary Secretary, Kyle McGinn MLC, to open the Ageing in Place village in Leonora. This is an exciting project providing a modern, independent living village for our senior residents to remain in their community, while being supported by local and visiting wrap around services. The project was funded through a \$3.5 million allocation from the Cook Labor Government's Regional Aged Accommodation Program, with a \$1 million contribution from the Shire of Leonora.



### Seniors Safety and Security Rebate

The Cook Labor Government is supporting Goldfield's seniors with the Seniors Safety and Security Rebate. The Rebate allows WA Seniors Card members to claim up to \$400 per household for items like Home Alarms, CCTV systems and security door and window screens. ### **Goldfields Seniors Directory**

The Goldfields Seniors Discount Directory, launched in 2022, is a joint project between myself, the Hon. Kyle McGinn MLC, and the Rotary Club of Kalgoorlie. Goldfield's seniors can access local business discounts. support services and seniorfriendly community groups in one free, easy to use Directory. It also encourages seniors to buy and shop locally.



We thank the participating businesses that have continued to support this initiative with generous discounts on goods and services. The new version will be bigger and better and available early in 2024.

### **Elder Abuse**

The Cook Labor Government is rolling out WA's strategy to prevent and respond to the abuse of older people. Added to this is a new diary, containing legal

information on how senior West Aussies can protect their rights.

To all the school Principals in the Goldfields and across Western Australia, thank you.




### **World Teachers Day**

# **COMMITMENTS BEING DELIVERED!!**



I catch up regularly with the Basketball 'Guru', Rob Tagliaferri, and get updates on the new Stadium.

The designs look amazing ...and the redevelopment is well underway! From mid-January 2024, you will start to see the structural steel going up and everyone is working hard getting the new stadium ready in late 2024.

It will feature two additional indoor courts - one as a show court with tiered spectator seating, plus refurbished existing courts, women's and men's home-and-away team change rooms, offices, a bar. function room, kitchen, and first-aid areas.

I was proud to advocate to the Cook Labor Government that provided \$5 million to build the Stadium.



### Karlkurla Nature Playground

The land has been cleared and construction is underway. We will have a new park ready early 2024!



Nature brings the best out of children - what better way to take advantage of this than building a massive nature playground in the beautiful setting of the 200-hectare Karlkurla Bushland Park.

The Cook Government is funding **\$600,000** towards this project, with the City of Kalgoorlie-Boulder contributing a further \$400,000. This will be worth waiting for and I can't wait to see the community enjoy all the new facilities.





### **Youth Precinct**

Kingsbury and Lord Forrest Parks will be unified into a central youth precinct.

This was one of my commitments, and with the Lotterywest Grant, the Government is providing \$4.3 million — with the City of Kalgoorlie-Boulder adding a further \$1.83 million. The Precinct will consist of skate park upgrades, a pump track, playscape, a multipurpose sports court, parkour and fitness zone, and a youth hub.

Work will begin on this project in February 2024 – it'll be exciting to watch this project come to fruition!



### **New TAFE Workshop**

This **\$10 million** Heavy Plant and **Engineering Trades Workshop is** being built at Central Regional TAFE - Kalgoorlie Campus. It's anticipated the new workshops will open in Semester 1, 2024.

The new workshop will deliver priority training in Mobile Plant Mechanic, Heavy Commercial Vehicle and Auto Electrical apprenticeship training, so locals can skill up for local jobs.

### **Brand New Full Circle Therapy Centre**

The Cook Labor Government has committed \$2.8 million for the construction of a purpose-built therapy centre for Full Circle. I look forward to seeing the construction of the new building in 2024.

### **Update on Housing and Land Releases**

Accommodation options are very important to the growth of our region, and I was grateful to see the City of Kalgoorlie-Boulder awarded \$4 million, through the Cook Labor Government's Infrastructure Development Fund. This will enable an extension of the main sewerage network to service 66.9 hectares of undeveloped land near the airport.

The land includes a 17.2-hectare site on Hart Kerspien Drive, for the development of a proposed 400-dwelling residential lifestyle village featuring one, two, three and four-bedroom homes.

Residential land supply has also received a major boost with the release of 28 new single residential lots and one-grouped housing lot.

These projects demonstrate the significant investment by the Cook Labor Government in housing and land supply. I'm delighted we are delivering these priority initiatives for Kalgoorlie-Boulder.
